ANNOUNCES PUBLICATION of VOTING AIDS

General Primary Election March 17, 2026

This announcement is calculated to reach the elderly and handicapped voter of the availability of registration and voting aids under the Federal Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act, of the availability of assistance in marking the ballot, procedures for voting by mail, and procedures for early voting by personal appearance.

Notice to Elderly and Voters with Disabilities

Citizens who are not registered to vote and are unable to leave his/her home, hospital, nursing home, or other institution because of a physical disability can arrange for voter registration by contacting a Deputy Registrar or the Saline County Clerk's Election Office. The Saline County Clerk's Office has complied with Federal and State election laws to promote the fundamental right to vote by improving access to voter registration and polling places. Voters who need to register to vote, transfer his/her voter registration to a new address within Saline County, or who will need special assistance with vote by mail voting, early voting or at the polls should contact the Saline County Clerk's Election Office at (618) 253-3028.
